



Kannapolis Cruise-In 2018 Rules and Guidelines

Cruise-In Dates and Hours 2018

March 10, April 14, May 12, September 8, October 13, November 101:00 PM – 7:00 PM

June 9, July 14, August 11....1:00 PM – 9:00 PM

Parking begins at 11:00 AM. – No Pre Parking will be allowed. Cabarrus Events Association (CEA) volunteers will direct parking until the loop is full.

No vehicles over 2 axles and/or larger than a Suburban will be allowed to park or cruise.

Cruising will begin at 1:00 PM.

Motorcycles are encouraged to cruise but are not allowed to park on the loop. A designated motorcycle parking area is provided.

Reserving/holding spaces will not be allowed. If you are with a club or group and wish to be parked together, we suggest you assemble before the event and CEA volunteers will help you find spaces together.

Absolutely no burnouts, displays of speed or power are allowed inside the Kannapolis Cruise-In area. Violators will be asked to leave immediately.

Due to the lack of shade, 10 x 10 (or smaller) pop up tents will be allowed behind parked cars. Tents must be weighted. No stakes allowed. Should a tent be moved by wind or other activity and damages a car, the tent owner is responsible for any and all damages to the car/cars. CEA is not responsible for any damages.

No skates, Skateboards, scooters, hover boards, or bicycles will be allowed on the loop.

No alcoholic beverages or vulgar behavior allowed.

All pets must be on a leash and owners must clean up after their pets.

Cruise In participants are responsible for cleaning their area and disposing of all trash in the bins provided.
